### **Evaluation methods**

- written questionnaires
- interviews
- participant observation
- desk study of project material and publications

### **Evaluation Plan**

- Desk study of material throughout project implementation
- Questionnaires for project partners and participants
- 4 visits with project partners to conduct interviews and observe activities
- Interim report (March 2014), final report (Jan/Feb 2015)
- Reporting to project partners at partners' meetings

#### **Questions for reflection & conversation**

- Does the project's *theory of change* apply equally in all countries and among all participating communities?
- What are the challenges in the selection of change agents and in terms of their involvement?
