Research-beforehand about the culture and customs of the audience: helps a lot for more conversation pieces.

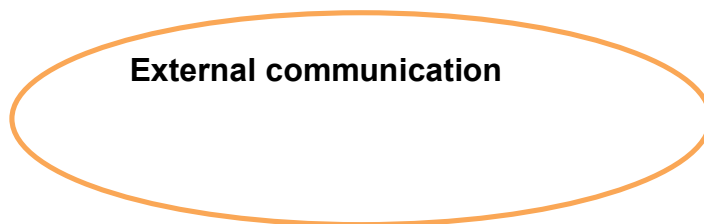
Politely but be funny to lure the atmosphere.
